The Star Carpet Cleaning Co. on the west side of Hermon St between 6th + 7th. In 1890 he is at 240 West 3rd St, And in 1891. He has become a policeman and his brother William is listed with him at 240 West 3rd. William may have been with J J from the start but the directory did not list minors and J J was 12 years older than William.

William Graney, age 84, 308 West 22nd St. Died Dec. 3, 1955.

He was born in County Cork, Ireland on April 8th 1872. He married Laura Hurley on Dec. 27, 1893. she died on Oct. 5, 1937.

He was survived by three daughters; Mrs. Charles Kennedy, Mrs Leo Hasenorl and Marcella. Three sons; Eugene Daniel, Emmet and Gerald.

He was preceded in death by two children, daughter Helen and son Lawrence.

Laura Hurley Graney age 63, died Oct. 5, 1937. She was survived by four sons; Lawrence, Emmet, Gerald and Eugene D., and three daughters, Mrs. Charles Kennedy, Lois & Marcella.

Lawrence Graney, age 48, Died Wed. Feb. 9, 1944 at 308 West 22nd. street. He was a veteran of World War I. He served in France from June 7, 1918 until July 8, 1919, a member of the 65th Co, Transportation Corp.

He was survived by his father and three sisters Mrs. Charles Kennedy, Lois and Marcella and three brothers Eugene D., Gerald F. and Emmet J.

John H. Graney, age 69, was first cousin of Eugene Daniel Graney, my brother-in-law. He was active in the Steelworker's Union. Born in Little Falls, N.Y. son of Mary Hannon Graney and John Graney. He lived with his cousin Marcella when he died. SEPT 14, 1956

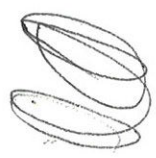
