PROFILE OF GENEALOGY COLLECTIONS

I. WEBS CATALOGS

- A. Main Catalog -- author entries for all published genealogies, subject entries for town and county histories.
- B. Genealogy Catalog -- entries by family name, arranged alphabetically.
- C. Union Catalog of American Genealogies -- family name entries for genealogies in the Western Reserve Historical Society, Library of Congress, New York Public Library and the Genealogical Society of Utah (Salt Lake City).
- D. Local History Catalog -- entries by city, county and state for transcriptions of births, marriages, cemeteries, probate, tax records, etc. Emphasis on Ohio and New England states.
- E. Newspaper Catalog -- entries by state and town of publication showing the library's holdings of 5,800 titles in approximately 25,000 bound volumes and many scattered issues.
- F. Maps and Atlas Catalogs -- place-name entries for a large map collection covering the United States, including many detailed state maps and various city maps showing ward boundaries.
- G. Periodical Catalog -- title entries for many journals published by state and local historical societies.

II. FAMILY HISTORIES

- A. More than 15,000 family histories in book, pamphlet, microfiche and manuscript form.
- B. Periodical publications of various family associations and genealogical societies.
- C. Rider's American Genealogical-Biographical Index, full name index to many genealogies and related sources. Most of the indexed sources are available in the library.
- D. Genealogical notices from the Boston Transcript, 1896-1941 (microfiche). This is considered the largest single source for New England genealogy and is indexed in Rider's.
- E. Kaminkov's Genealogies in the Library of Congress, with Supplement and Complement.
- F. Greenlaw's descriptive index of genealogies in the library of the New England Historic Genealogical Society.
- G. I.G.I. index to more than 88 million names recorded in the genealogical files of the L.D.S. (Mormon) church.

- A. All available United States federal population schedules from 1790 through 1900, 1910 census for Ohio and Pennsylvania.

- C. 1900 Census Enumeration District Descriptions.
- D. Printed census indices for most states through 1850. For Ohio, through 1860.
- E. 1890 Special Census of Union veterans and their widows, Ohio only.

BIRTH RECORDS

The Ohio law requiring births to be recorded was passed in 1907. Records may not exist for persons born before 1907. After December 20, 1908, birth records are usually kept in the city where the birth occurred as well as at the state level. Remember that for many years most births occurred at home and that city boundaries change.

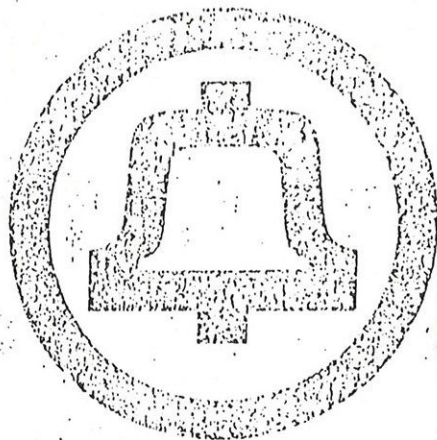
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
