When that was torn down during the downtown renewal program and a new theater was built and met 10th between State and Beach. He worked there and so did his first wife Martha. When the theater closed he became a security guard at American Standard Co.

On May 3, 1922 he married Martha Myers and they had two daughters Florence M B \_\_\_\_\_ and Dolores B \_\_\_\_\_.

John Joseph Conyngham was born in Ireland on June 22, 1848, the son of Richard Conyngham and Mary Hickey Conyngham. He had eight brothers and sisters and the following is the information I have on them

Michael Conyngham. Born Oct 10, 1847 Ireland. He lived at 32 Fairview Avenue, Borough of Richmond, N. Y. City. He died there on Dec 4, 1913 and is buried in St. Peter's Cemetery, N.Y.C. The 1910 Census list Michael, his wife Anna and two step-daughters Mary J. Henderson and Nettie Johnson.

Thomas Cunningham Born <sup>Oct 1 1836</sup> ~~June 22, 1848~~ Ireland. He lived in Cui, Pa at 705 East 11th Street. He died March 28, 1912 in Cui and is buried in Trinity Cemetery. He was married to Mary Morrison she was born Nov 22, 1848. Died April 14, 1939. They had 5 children. Anna, Nettie and Mrs. William McLeod, Thomas C. (an employee of the Times) and William J. Cunningham.

He was a motion picture projecrionist. He worked at the Strand theater when it was located on State St. between ninth and tenth streets. When this building was torn down for urban renewal he worked at other jobs until the new theater on west tenth st, was built. (I did meet him at the lumber yard in the 800 block of east tenth st. during this time and he told me he worked there part-time). When the new theater was built, both he and his wife Martha worked there. She was cashier and ran the candy and pop-corn stand and he was the projectionist.

On May 3, 1922 he married Martha Myers (Born May 30, 1902- Died April 24, 1968) and they had two daughters; Florence M Born Dec. 13, 1924 and Dolores Born April 10, 1931.

Sometime after the death of Martha, Joseph married for the second time. His second wife was Lucille Hill, the widow of Irwin Hill. Lucille died January 2, 1980
