The first record of Henry (Heinrich) Baumgartner, my great grandfather, is the City of Erie Directory of 1853. He is listed as a shoemaker working for H Neubauer.

Henry was born in 1808. (I don't have the month and date) He emigrated to the U.S. in 1851. His ~~sponsor~~ cert. of citizenship was given Sept 16, 1866. His sponsor was Henry Neubauer. He was born in the Rhine Baron. His certificate is # 2691

There are no street addresses in the 1860 census, nor the date of entry of immigrants. The family is listed as follows

HAWKINS FAMILY

The Hawkins Family were Irish Potato Famine Immigrants.
I don't know where in Ireland they came from, but I know that
part of the family landed in New York City, January 25, 1849 on
the ship St. Patrick, sailing from Liverpool, Eng.

Those on board were Michael, age 50^(?), Thomas age 24, Hugh
age 18 (My great-grandfather), Nancy , age 21 and Honora, age
14. All listed as laborers and spinsters. (Spinsters, meaning
they ran spinning wheels, not that they were old maids.)

The 1850 Census shows all the family in Clifton Springs,
Ontario County, New York State. They are as follows:

band in St. Peter's in Conneautville, Pa.

William was killed on Sept. 13, 1911 when he came in con-
tact with a live wire near the Reed Mfg. Plant on West 8th St.
in Erie, Pa. He is buried (No stone) in the common grave sec-
tion of Trinity Cemetery in Erie. (Grave 6-row 24)

gartner and Franz Jacob Vogel. She was born Mar. 27, 1865
in Erie, Pa. and she died there Aug. 8, ¹⁹³¹ 1931. She is buried
with most of her family in Erie Cemetery.
